Scholarship Eligibility Requirements**

**Eligibility Requirements for Current High School Students
(including CCBC Parallel enrolled and dual credit students):**

- Be a 2018 high school graduate
- Have been actively involved in at least 1 CPM show during the 2016 – 2017 season (September 2016 – May 2017)
- Have a minimum cumulative high school GPA of 2.5
- Write a one-page essay, single spaced in Times New Roman 12 Pt. Font, answering this question: *How has CPM influenced your decision to attend CCBC?*
- Complete and return all documentation in the check list below -

Eligibility Requirements for current CCBC Students (1st time CPM scholarship applicants only):

- Be a current CCBC full-time student
- Have been actively involved in at least 3 CPM shows during your high school years
- Have a minimum cumulative CCBC GPA of 2.5
- Write a one-page essay, single spaced in Times New Roman 12 Pt. Font, answering this question: *How has CPM has influenced your decision to attend CCBC?*
- Complete and return all documentation in the check list below

Terms of Eligibility:

This scholarship is for one semester and is expected to be used towards expenses incurred at CCBC. Scholarship recipient must be enrolled at CCBC as full-time CCBC student or a high school student taking either a minimum of 6 CCBC credits or be in a dual credit program during the semester for which the scholarship is awarded

Applications that are incomplete, missing required documentation, or received after the March 31st, 2018 deadline will not be reviewed, and student will be deemed ineligible

This scholarship is renewable for a second semester at CCBC provided the scholarship recipient fills out the scholarship renewal form, has a 2.5 GPA and agrees to volunteer a minimum of 14 hours at CPM during the semester for which the scholarship is extended

Award Amount:

The CPM-CCBC scholarship award amount shall be determined annually by the CPM Board of Directors.

Award Disbursement:

The CPM scholarship disbursement will be decided by a committee comprised of individuals with no children currently participating in CPM and at least one representative of CCBC.

Required Documents for Scholarship Consideration**

The following documents are required and must be included with your application. Failure to include any required document will disqualify your application. No electronic submissions allowed.

Documents must arrive at the CPM office by March 31st, 2018

Completed CPM\CCBC Scholarship Application

Official High School Transcript or CCBC Transcript.

- Current high school students must submit their official High School transcript in a sealed envelope. Transcript should include all high school classes taken and grades up to and including the first semester of grade 12
- High school graduates who are current CCBC Students must submit their CCBC transcript (official or unofficial). Transcript should include all previous semester(s) CCBC classes and grades.

Personal Resume

Resume should include school and/or CCBC activities, (i.e. clubs, committees, band, arts, sports), leadership positions, honor societies, awards\recognitions received, volunteer and community service, active memberships in community organizations, and current employment

Theater Resume

A resume listing all acting and technical theatre experience. Please include name of show, role played\technical position held, theatre\school name, and director's name

A Letter of Recommendation

This letter must be from an adult, non-family member (i.e. teacher, counselor, coach, religious leader) and should be on professional letterhead and must be signed.

Essay

One-page essay, single spaced in Times New Roman 12 Pt. Font, answering this question:
"How has CPM influenced your decision to attend CCBC??"
