Scholarship Eligibility Requirements**

Eligibility Requirements for Current High School Students

- Be a high school student currently taking CCBC classes or expected to graduate high school in 2023 • Have been actively involved with a minimum of 1 CPM show during your high school years
- Have a minimum cumulative high school GPA of 2.5.
- Write a one-page essay, single spaced in Times New Roman 12 Pt. Font, answering this question: *How has CPM influenced your decision to attend CCBC?*
- Complete and return all documentation in the check list below.

Eligibility Requirements for current CCBC Students

- Be a current CCBC student taking a minimum of 3 credits.
- Have been actively involved with a minimum of 1 CPM show during your high school years (grades 9 -12).
- Have a minimum cumulative CCBC GPA of 2.5.
- Write a one-page essay, single spaced in Times New Roman 12 Pt. Font, answering this question: *How has CPM influenced your decision to attend CCBC?*
- Complete and return all documentation in the check list below.

Eligibility Requirements for CPM Family Members

- Be enrolled at CCBC and registered for a minimum of 3 college credits.
- Meet one of the following criteria:
 - Be a CPM Alumni who was involved in a minimum of 2 shows while in high school
 - Have a child\sibling who has been involved in a CPM show during the past 2 CPM seasons.
 - Be a current CPM staff member or child\spouse of a staff or board member.
- Write a one-page essay, single spaced in Times New Roman 12 Pt. Font answering this question: *How has CPM influenced your decision to attend CCBC?*
- Complete and return all documentation in the check list below.

Terms of Eligibility:

Applicants should be in good standing with the Playhouse. Any outstanding obligations, financial or otherwise, need to be resolved before any application will be reviewed.

This scholarship is for one semester and is expected to be used towards expenses incurred at CCBC. Scholarship recipients must be enrolled at CCBC and registered for a minimum of 3 CCBC credits.

If funds are available, this scholarship may be renewable for a second semester at CCBC provided the scholarship recipient fills out the scholarship renewal form, has a 2.5 GPA and agrees to volunteer a minimum of 14 hours at CPM during the semester for which the scholarship is extended.

Award Amount and Disbursement:

The CPM-CCBC scholarship award amount shall be determined annually by the CPM Board of Directors. The CPM scholarship disbursement will be decided by a committee comprised of individuals with no children currently participating in CPM and at least one representative of CCBC.

Required Documents for Scholarship Consideration**

The following documents are required as noted and must be included with your application. Failure to include any required document will disqualify your application. No electronic submissions allowed. **Documents must arrive at the CPM office by September 1st 2023**

Completed CPM\CCBC Scholarship Application (All applicants)

High School Transcript or CCBC Transcript (Current students only)

Current high school students must submit their *official High School* transcript in a sealed envelope. Transcript should include all high school classes taken and grades up to and including the first semester of grade 12.

High school graduates who are current CCBC Students must submit their CCBC transcript (official or unofficial). Transcript should include all previous semester(s) CCBC classes and grades.

Personal Resume (All applicants)

Resume should include school and/or CCBC activities, (i.e. clubs, committees, band, arts, sports), leadership positions, honor societies, awards\recognitions received, volunteer and community service, active memberships in community organizations, and current employment

Theater Resume (Required for current CPM students and alumni, optional for all others)

A resume listing all acting and technical theatre experience. Please include name of show, date, role played\technical position held, theatre\school name, and director's name

A Letter of Recommendation (All applicants)

This letter must be from an adult, non-family member (i.e. teacher, counselor, coach, religious leader), should be on a professional letterhead and must be signed.

Essay (All applicants)

One-page essay, single spaced in Times New Roman 12 Pt. Font, answering this question:
"How has CPM influenced your decision to attend CCBC?"
